REQUEST BY DOUGLAS GARRISON, WISH TV, INDIANAPOLIS


On November 29, 2006, Douglas S. Garrison ("Requestor"), WISH TV, Indianapolis, delivered a written request under the Indiana Public Access Records Act (I.C. 5-14-3-1, *et seq.*). A copy of that request is attached to this order for reference. In that request, the Requestor asks for a copy of the "transcript taken during an in camera hearing" held on October 30, 2006.

The transcripts of the *in camera* interviews of jurors and security staff has been prepared by the Court Reporter and released to counsel for the State and the Defendant, not for public access.

The Court has redacted the transcript to remove juror names in accordance with Jury Rule 10, and remove a cell phone number in accordance with Administrative Rule 9. The redacted transcript is released for public access.

The redacted transcript has been scanned into electronic form and released to the Court's media liaison, Mr. David Remondini, this date for electronic (e-mail) distribution to the Requestor and to all other media representatives.
